General Safeguarding and Welfare Requirement: Equal Opportunities

32. Supporting children with special educational needs and disabilities

Ducklings pre-school policy statement

- We have regard for the Special Educational Needs and Disability Code of Practice (2015).
- We have in place a clear approach for identifying, responding to, and meeting children's Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).
- We support and involve parents (and where relevant children), actively listening to, and acting on their wishes and concerns.
- We work in partnership with the local authority and other external agencies to ensure the best outcomes for children with SEND and their families.
- We regularly monitor and review our policy, practice and provision and, if necessary, make adjustments.

Procedures

- We designate a member of staff to be the Special Educational Needs and disabilities Co-ordinator (SENDCo) and give her name to parents. Our SENDCo is Chris Saunders.
- The SENDCo works closely with the pre-school supervisor Julie Cook and other colleagues and has responsibility for the day-to-day operation of our Supporting Children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Policy and for co-ordinating provision for children with SEND.
- We ensure that the provision for children with SEND is the responsibility of all members of the pre-school.
- We ensure that our inclusive admissions practice ensures equality of access and opportunity.
- We have a Single Equality Scheme in place to ensure inclusive good practice.
- We provide a broad, balanced and differentiated curriculum for all children.
- We apply SEND support to ensure early identification of children with SEND.
- We use the graduated approach system (assess, plan, do and review) applied in increasing detail and frequency to ensure that children progress.
- We ensure that parents are involved at all stages of the assessment, planning, provision and review of their children's special education including all decision making processes
- Where appropriate, we take into account children's views and wishes in decisions being made about them, relevant to their level understanding.
- We provide parents with information on local sources of support and advice e.g. Local Offer, Information, Advice and Support Service.
- We liaise and work with other external agencies to help improve outcomes for children with SEND.
- We have systems in place for referring children for further assessment e.g. Request for support, Early Help
 Assessment and Education, Health and Care (EHC) assessment.

- We make reasonable adjustments and provide resources (human and financial) to implement supporting children with our Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Policy.
- We ensure that all our staff are aware of our Supporting Children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Policy and the procedures for identifying, assessing and making provision for children with SEND. We provide inservice training for parents, practitioners and volunteers.
- We raise awareness of our special education provision via our website.
- We ensure the effectiveness of our special educational needs provision by collecting information from a range of sources e.g. action plan reviews, staff meetings, parental and external agency's views, inspections and complaints. This information is collated, evaluated and reviewed annually.
- We provide a Making a Complaint policy (42).
- We monitor and review our policy annually.
